2024 LAST-MINUTE DONATIONS – Important Note From The Treasurer

Dear Church Family,

As we approach the end of the year, please take note of the following guidelines for 2024 donations:

OFFERING COLLECTION DEADLINE:

The last Sabbath for tithes and offerings via the offering collection is Dec 28. Donations received after this date will be processed for 2025, even if the cheque is dated 2024.

OTHER DONATION METHODS:

Adventist Giving: Donations are accepted until midnight on Dec 31.

- *E-Transfers:* Donations via e-transfer must be processed by your bank before midnight on Dec 31. The timestamp of the confirmation email reflects when the e-transfer was processed, not when it was sent. Please allow time for this to be reflected.
- *Mailed Donations:* Donations must be postmarked by Dec 31. Please ensure the postal clerk postmarks your envelope and notify the office of your mailed donation.

DONATION DROP-OFFS:

Please do not drop donations in the church mailbox, slide them under the office door, or leave them in the treasurer's mailbox. Such donations will be recorded for 2025.

CHEQUE DONATIONS:

- *Please ensure* there are sufficient funds in your bank account to cover your cheque. NSF cheques will not be included in your 2024 receipt.
- *Donations* are receipted based on the name on the cheque, bank account, or credit card. Ensure the name on your offering envelope matches the name on your cheque. This applies to Adventist Giving and e-transfers as well.

ENSURING PROPER RECEIPT INFORMATION:

- *Ensure* your full name and address are legible on your offering envelope. If you donate by e-transfer without registering, the treasurer may not have your address. Please contact the office to confirm or provide your details.
- *If you wish* to receive your receipt by email, please provide your email address to the office. Emailed receipts are sent out sooner than printed ones. If you choose email, you won't receive a printed copy.

RECEIPTS DISTRIBUTION:

While we aim to distribute receipts by Feb 28, Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) does not have a deadline. Printed receipts will be placed in church mailboxes or mailed to those who don't have an email address. Please check your email (including spam) by the end of February to ensure you receive your receipt.

CRA DONATION DATE RULES:

The CRA considers the donation date to be when the gift is received by church. For mailed donations, the donation date is the postmark on the envelope. We will keep the stamped envelope as part of our records. Non-compliance with CRA rules could result in penalties for both the church and the donor.
