DATA From **2009 - 2025**

- **1,627** Bags given out!
- Average Area **20.8 ft²**/quilt.
- Average Top Stitching and Binding **19,300** stitches/quilt.
 - Varies from ~**4,600** stitches (small quilt) to over **90,000** stitches (large complex quilt).
- Top, Batting and Bottom Material **101,620 ft²**
 - Would be enough to **Carpet 56 Homes** that are, **1,800 ft²**.
- Total Top Stitching and Binding: **34.9 Million** Stitches.
- Thread Length for **34.9 Million** stitches would extend out in a straight line **177 km**.

Calgary -----> 177 km to Lethbridge.
